A Puzzling Presentation: A Case Report of Jaundice*

A 13 year old male came with the complaint of jaundice (as shown in Figure 1 and 2). The patient presented with yellow conjunctiva, a bitter taste in the mouth, sour and yellow vomitus, a pale yellow complexion, a thirst for cold drinks, bilious vomiting, discomfort in the upper abdomen (left) with heartburn and flatulence, nausea after eating, dark mustard-colored urine, frequent episodes of diarrhea, and generalized itching of the skin throughout the body.

For the treatment of these symptoms, Natrum sulphuricum 6 CH was prescribed. The patient was instructed to take 5 drops of the remedy in 1 tablespoon of lukewarm water three times a day.
